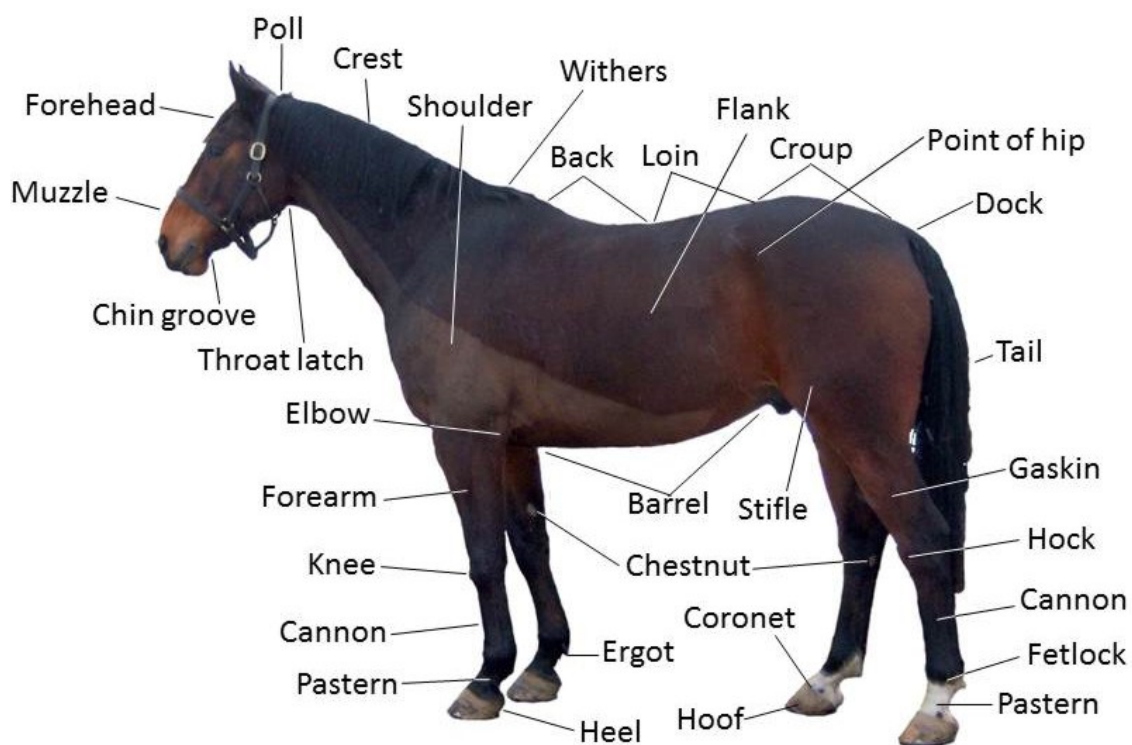

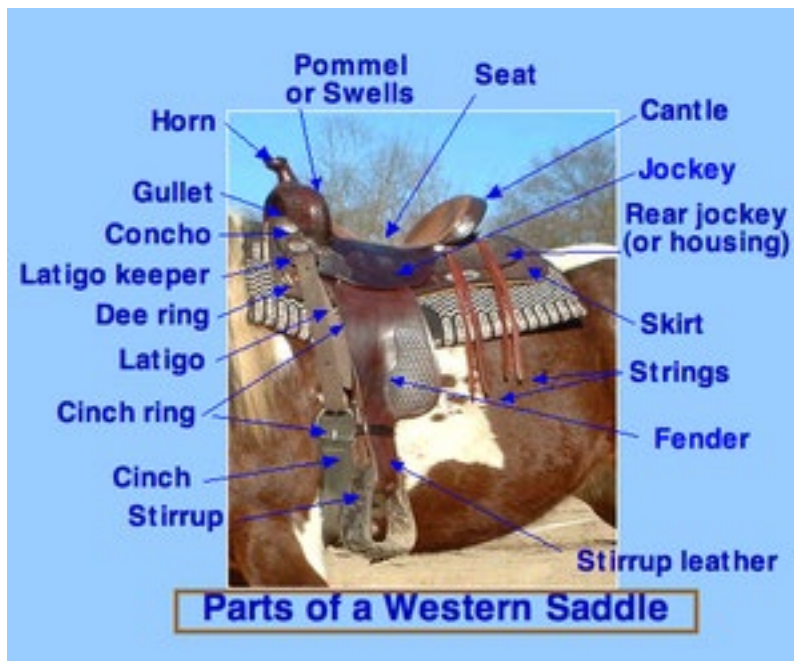
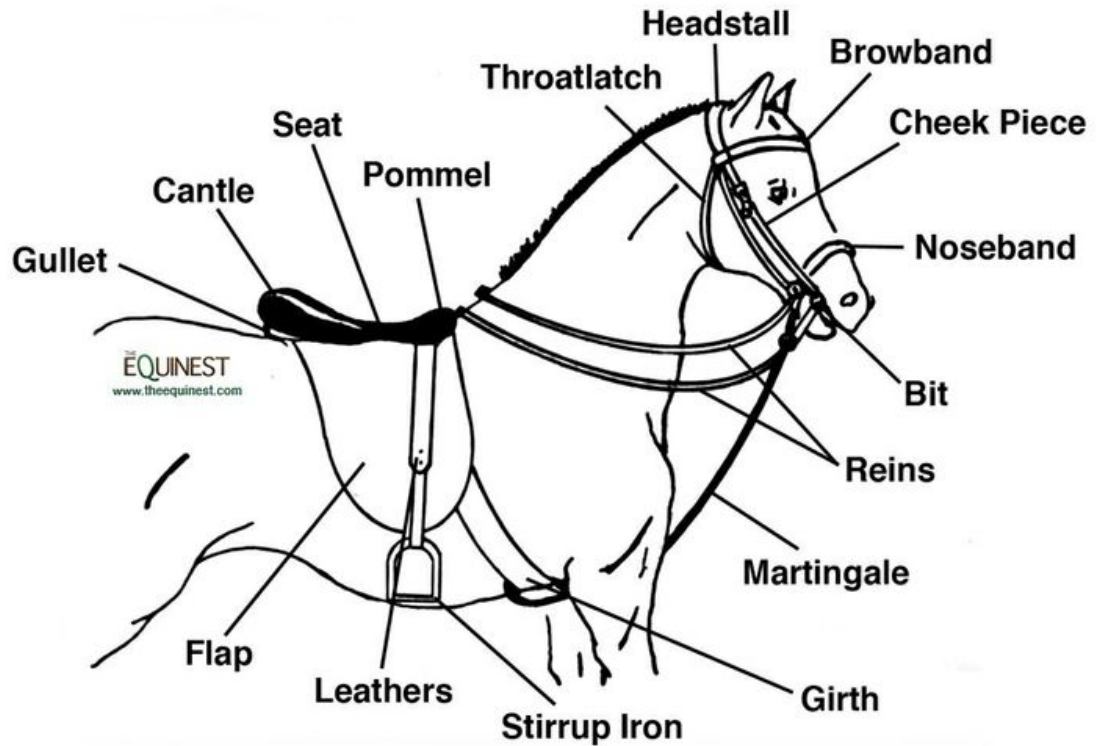
SECTION 9 - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS;

- **ARE THERE DIFFERENT TYPES OF RIDING STYLES?**

ANSWER. YES – THE MAIN RIDING STYLES ARE ENGLISH AND WESTERN. THE DIFFERENCE IN THESE STYLES OF RIDING IS IN THE EQUIPMENT USED AS WELL AS THE INSTRUCTION FOR RIDERS AND HORSES.

ENGLISH SADDLES ARE SMALLER AND SIMPLER THAN WESTERN ONES. WESTERN SADDLES ALSO HAVE A HORN AND MUCH HEAVIER STIRRUPS. ALSO THE GIRTH USED FOR EACH SADDLE IS DIFFERENT AS IS THE PADS THAT NEED TO GO UNDERNEATH EACH TYPE OF SADDLE.







WESTERN BRIDLES GENERALLY ARE SIMPLER THAN ENGLISH BRIDLES.

- **WHAT OTHER TYPE OF EQUIPMENT IS NECESSARY WHEN OWNING A HORSE.**

ANSWER. A FEW OF THE NECESSARY ITEMS IS A NYLON OR LEATHER HALTER, LEAD ROPE AND A VARIETY OF BRUSHES AND GROOMING SUPPLIES.



- **WHAT TYPE OF CARE DOES A HORSE NEED?**

ANSWER. ALTHOUGH HORSES ARE GENERALLY PRETTY GOOD AT SURVIVING THEY DO NEED GRAIN AND/OR HAY ON A DAILY BASIS ALONG WITH A SOURCE OF FRESH CLEAN WATER. THEY NEED TO HAVE A SHELTER WHICH HELPS THEM STAY OUT OF THE WIND. MOST HORSES ALSO NEED AND SHOULD HAVE THE ABILITY TO WALK OR BE TURNED OUT FOR AT LEAST HALF A DAY IN ORDER TO HELP KEEP THEIR MUSCLE TONE, NOT TO MENTION IT HELPS TO STOP HORSES FROM CRIBBING (WHICH IS A HABIT THAT DEVELOPS WHEN HORSES ARE KEPT IN STALLS FOR LONG PERIODS OF TIME).

HORSES WILL GROW A WINTER COAT TO PROTECT THEM FROM WINTER COLD WHICH NATURALLY SHEDS WHEN THE DAYS GET LONGER AND WARMER.

HORSES HOOVES NEED TO BE TRIMMED BY A FARRIER EVERY EIGHT TO TWELVE WEEKS, ESPECIALLY THOSE HORSES THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ROAM OUTSIDE OF THEIR ENCLOSURES. SOME HORSES REQUIRE SHOES ON ALL FOUR HOOVES, OTHERS ONLY ON THE FRONT AND OTHERS NOT AT ALL AND NEED ONLY TO HAVE THEIR HOOVES TRIMMED.

BRUSHING IS A NECESSARY ACTIVITY TO HELP KEEP HORSES HAIR FROM MATTING AND/OR GETTING FUNGUS SUCH AS RAIN ROT. ALTHOUGH HORSES NATURALLY, LIKE MOST OTHER ANIMALS, USE ROLLING IN DIRT TO HELP THEM KEEP BUGS FROM BITING THEM AND OR REMOVE UNWANTED EXTRA HAIR, IT'S IMPORTANT TO TRY TO NOT HAVE ANYTHING WHICH WOULD MAKE A HORSE UNCOMFORTABLE WHEN PUTTING A PAD AND SADDLE ON A HORSE. THEREFORE ESPECIALLY WHEN GETTING READY TO RIDE IT IS IMPORTANT TO GROOM ESPECIALLY AROUND THE AREA WHERE THE SADDLE WILL SIT OR THE GIRTH WILL BE ON THE HORSE.

HORSES ARE HERD ANIMALS AND GENERALLY DO BETTER WHEN THERE IS AT LEAST ONE OTHER ANIMAL FOR THEM TO BOND WITH. THIS IS USUALLY ANOTHER HORSE BUT COULD BE ANOTHER ANIMAL SUCH AS A DONKEY, MINATURE HORSE OR GOAT.

- **DO HORSES NEED ANNUAL SHOTS OR TEETH EXAMS?**

ANSWER. YES. HORSES GENERALLY NEED TO HAVE ANNUAL VACCINATIONS IN THE SPRING AND SOMETIMES IN THE FALL. THERE ARE ALSO ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS IF YOU ARE SHOWING YOUR HORSE AT VARIOUS FACILITIES AND THEY ARE EXPOSED TO OTHER HORSES. YOUR LOCAL VETERINARIAN WOULD BE ABLE TO GUIDE YOU ON WHAT IS GENERALLY GIVEN IN YOUR AREA.

TEETH ON HORSES ARE EXAMINED AND "FLOATED" TO GET RID OF SHARP EDGES. THIS IS GENERALLY DONE EVERY TWO YEARS ONCE A HORSE IS AN ADULT. HORSES GENERALLY EAT WITH THEIR BACK TEETH AND THEREFORE IT'S VERY IMPORTANT THAT THEY BE CHECKED ON A REGULAR BASIS BY YOUR VET OR AN EQUINE DENTIST.

- **DO HORSES NEED WORMED ON A REGULAR BASIS?**

ANSWER. HORSES DO NEED TO BE WORMED BUT THE FREQUENCY AND TYPE OF WORMER TO BE USED IS ANSWERED DIFFERENTLY BY VARIOUS HORSE OWNERS AND EXPERTS. OFTEN TIMES A FECAL EXAM IS DONE BY YOUR VET TO DETERMINE WHAT TYPE IF ANY WORMS MAY BE PRESENT AND THEN A SPECIFIC WORMER WILL BE ADMINISTERED ORALLY TO THE HORSE TO GET RID OF THE PARASITES. WORMERS CAN BE PURCHASED ON LINE OR AT TRACTOR SUPPLY. USUALLY THIS IS DONE AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR AND IN SOME CASES MORE OFTEN. PRIOR CONVENTION WAS TO WORM HORSES AT LEAST THREE TO FIVE TIMES A YEAR NO MATTER WHAT BUT CURRENTLY IT IS BELIEVED THAT ADMINISTERING WORMER PRIOR TO DETERMINING IF THERE IS ANY WORMS PRESENT IS EXPOSING YOUR HORSE TO UNNECESSARY CHEMICALS AND MAKES THE WORMS RESISTANT TO THESE CHEMICALS.

- **IF I WANTED TO OWN A HORSE, WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?**

ANSWER. FIRST IT IS IMPORTANT TO DETERMINE IF YOU WANT A HORSE TO DO WESTERN RIDING, FOR INSTANCE ON TRAILS OR WESTERN SHOWS, OR ENGLISH RIDING FOR SHOWS OR TRAILS. HORSES ARE GENERALLY TRAINED IN ONE DISCIPLINE OR ANOTHER AND CHANGING THEM AFTER YEARS OF A PARTICULAR TYPE OF RIDING IS NOT GENERALLY ADVISABLE OR EASY.

ONCE YOU HAVE DECIDED WHAT TYPE OF HORSEBACK RIDING YOU ARE INTERESTED IN, THEN YOU NEED TO LOOK AT FACILITIES WHICH HAVE THOSE TYPE OF HORSES TO SEE IF THERE ARE ANY UP FOR SALE SO YOU CAN SEE THE HORSE YOU ARE INTERESTED IN AND POSSIBLY RIDE THEM, ETC. OFTEN TIMES PEOPLE WHO OWN HORSES ARE WILLING TO LEASE A HORSE FOR A CERTAIN FEE AND PERIOD OF TIME WHICH ALLOWS YOU THE ABILITY TO RIDE BUT NOT HAVE THE ISSUES OF OWNERSHIP.

SOMETIMES OLDER HORSES WHO CANNOT BE RIDDEN ON AN EXTENDED BASIS WILL BE DONATED BUT AS A HORSE GETS OLDER ITS ABILITY TO PROVIDE EXTENSIVE RIDING DIMINISHES. ALSO ITS FEED REQUIREMENTS TEND TO REQUIRE ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTS AND ADDITIVES. HOWEVER, AN OLDER HORSE JUST LIKE AN OLDER DOG OR CAT, SHOULD NOT BE OVERLOOKED ESPECIALLY FOR BEGINNING AND YOUNGER RIDERS AS A PLACE TO START AS THEY PROVIDE THE TIME TO LET AN INDIVIDUAL LEARN HOW TO CARE FOR AND RIDE A HORSE SAFELY AND RESPONSIBLY.

- **HOW LONG DO HORSES LIVE?**

ANSWER. IT DEPENDS. GENERALLY MOST HORSES LIVE TO BE ABOUT 30 TO 35 YEARS OLD. ALTHOUGH LARGER BREEDS LIVE ONLY TO ABOUT 25 YEARS WITH SMALLER ONES TO ABOUT 45 YEARS. USUALLY MOST HORSES CAN BE LIGHTLY RIDDEN UNTIL THEY ARE ABOUT 30. THERE DOES COME A POINT WHERE A HORSE MAY THROUGH AGE OR INJURY BE ONLY ABLE TO BE A PASTURE BUDDY AND NOT RIDABLE. EACH PERSON HAS TO DECIDE HOW THEY NEED TO DEAL WITH SUCH A SITUATION AS HORSES ARE EXPENSIVE, ESPECIALLY IF THEY ARE NOT RIDABLE. HOWEVER, THESE ARE THINGS THAT MUST BE CONSIDERED WHEN PURCHASING OR BECOMING A HORSE OWNER. YOUR LOCAL VET MAY BE ABLE TO HELP DEAL WITH SOME OF THESE DECISIONS.

- **DO HORSES BOND WITH THEIR OWNERS?**

ANSWER. YES HORSES GENERALLY BOND WITH OTHER HORSES AND PEOPLE WHO TAKE CARE OF THEM. IT IS VERY TRAUMATIC FOR THEM TO HAVE TO CHANGE FACILITIES AND/OR ROUTINES AND/OR OWNERS. PEOPLE SHOULD BE MINDFUL OF HOW THESE CHANGES AFFECT HORSES AND ALLOW THEM TIME TO ADJUST TO NEW PLACES AND PEOPLE BEFORE EXPECTING TOO MUCH FROM THEM. A FEW WEEKS USUALLY IS HELPFUL TO ALLOW A NEW ANIMAL TO ADJUST AND TO FEEL COMFORTABLE IN ITS NEW SURROUNDINGS. REMEMBER

HORSES ARE NATURALLY FLIGHT ANIMALS WHO'S EXISTENCE GENERALLY DEPENDED ON THEIR BEING ABLE TO LEAVE A SITUATION IF IT SCARED THEM. THEREFORE IT IS IMPORTANT TO GAIN THE TRUST OF A HORSE TO HELP THEM WORK THROUGH ANY STRESSFUL SITUATION AND THEY IN TURN WILL DO THE SAME FOR YOU.
